THE PESHMARGAS OF KOMALA : OFFENSIVE AGAIN,  
VICTORY AGAIN

The Islamic Republic regime, which last year gave the face of an occupied territory to Kurdistan by concentrating nearly 200 thousand soldiers in military centres in towns, villages and strategic points, etc. in the spring and summer of this year tries to consolidate its presence in Kurdistan by setting up bases and camps in every strategically important village in order to limit, in its own mind, the mobility and flexibility of the Peshmarga forces and by reducing the distances between its military bases to increase its power of defence against the surprise attacks of the Peshmargas and ensure the security of movement of its forces.

On the basis of their continuous presence in the occupied regions, the Peshmargas of Komala have intensified their attacks against the military centres of the enemy in the heart of these regions. Consequently, during the last month, 7 military bases and camps of the enemy have been taken and destroyed by the attacks of the Peshmargas ; hundreds of men from the enemy camp have been killed and tens have been taken captive and considerable quantities of arms and munition have been taken as booty. All this shows the invincible power and the remarkable cohesion of the Peshmarga forces, their military skills and efficiency and their ability to adopt right military tactics in a partisan war. During these battles, the masses of the people have unreservedly supported the Peshmargas. Without such a support, such courageous and victorious operations could not have been possible.

Only in five days, i.e. from 10th to 14th July, three bases and camps of the regime in the heart of the most occupied territories of Kurdistan have been entirely taken by the Peshmargas of Komala.

CONQUEST OF TWO BASES AND ONE CAMP IN  
THE REGION OF SANANDAJ

On the evening of 10th July, at 22.45, the Peshmargas of Komala from the 11th brigade of Sanandaj, took in less than 30 minutes one of the bases and a camp of the enemy in the village of Tavar Molla, 10 km to the north-west of Sanandaj, on the Sanandaj-Marivan road. During this operation which took place in commemoration of three of our martyr comrades a considerable number of the enemy men were killed or wounded and 13 were taken captive ; a few escaped. The body of the commander of the base was among those killed.

Our comrades have taken the following booty :

- 18 G 3 guns,
- 2 Kalachnikov guns,
- 1 machine gun G 3,
- 12000 bullets,
- 106 cartridges,
- 25 hand and gun grenades
- 1 wireless PRC 77,
- 2 desert telephones
- as well as considerable quantities of materials.

Two of the captives (Hassan RAVANBAKHS and Seyed KHOSHBAKHT) who were wounded during the battle were freed after receiving preliminary medical treatment according to the revolutionary policy of Komala. Among the killed, six were identified. Our comrades suffered no casualty in this battle.

#### SANANDAJ

On the 14th July, following their repeated offensives, our comrade Peshmargas attacked the major base of the enemy in the village of Goricheh near the Sanandaj-Marivan road. They took possession of and destroyed the base. During this rapid operation, all the men in the base except two who were taken captive, were killed. Our comrades took considerable quantities of arms, munition and other military equipments.

CONQUEST OF THREE MILITARY CENTRES  
OF THE ENEMY BY THE PESHMARGAS OF KOMALA

SANANDAJ

On the evening of 10th July, the Peshmargas of Komala captured a military base and a military position of the Islamic Republic, located 10 km to the north-west of Sanandaj. During the fighting for the base, which lasted not more than half-an-hour, 13 of the regime's fighters were taken captive and many more were killed and wounded; the commander of the base was among those killed. Our comrades suffered no casualties; they also took a lot of booty. Two of the captured, who were wounded, were released on the spot after preliminary medical treatment.

SANANDAJ

On the evening of 14th July, the Peshmargas of Komala attacked, captured and destroyed the biggest military base of the Islamic Republic regime in the village of Goricheh, situated near the Sanandaj-Marivan road. During this operation all but two of the personnel of the base were killed and a heavy loss was sustained by the enemy; the two were taken captive.

MARIVAN

On 18th July, in a village near the Marivan-Saghez road the forces of the regime tried to ambush the Peshmargas of Komala. Noticing the presence of the enemy, the Peshmargas lost no time in responding to the attacks of the enemy forcing it to retreat with some losses.

IN THE WAR FRONTS AGAINST THE  
FORCES OF DPKI

MARIVAN

In the afternoon of 2nd July, a number of DPKI people in the Sarshiv district started to move towards the camp of the Peshmargas of Komala. Our comrades stopped their advance and forced them to retreat. In this confrontation, the men from the DPKI suffered certain casualties but no casualty was sustained by our comrades.

In a confrontation in the afternoon of 3rd July between the two sides, which followed the movement of the DPKI forces from several directions towards the heights where the Peshmargas of Komala had their camp, the forces of DPKI suffered some casualties and had to

retreat. In this three-hour battle, two of our comrades were slightly wounded.

Seven of the war captives were released from the jails of Komala after having attended literacy classes and receiving political education.

They were the regime's conscript pasdars and members of the "Reconstruction Jihad" who had been taken captive by our comrades in battlefields.

#### MARIVAN

On 3rd July, one of the people who had been armed at the service of the Islamic regime, gave himself up to the Peshmargas of Komala with his gun and munition and hand-grenade. He was welcomed by the Peshmargas.

#### BANEH

Starting on 9th July, our Peshmargas comrades in the Baneh region carried out for five days their political-military propagan-da tour in the villages of Sorkiv of Baneh. This region has been occupied by the forces of the regime for two years. In this tour, our comrades explained the policies of Komala as regards the problems of the movement in Kurdistan and its prospective ; they spoke about the Iran-Iraq war and the precarious situation of the regime. They also emphasized the correctness of the policies of Komala with regard to the confrontations between Komala and the forces of DPKI. This tour was warmly welcomed by the people of the region.

#### SANANDAJ

In the afternoon of 4th July, three Iraqi fighter-bombers bombed the Sanandaj garrison. Hitting the dormitory of the military personnel, the bombs killed 250 and wounded 215 soldiers. On their way back, the planes also bombarded the surrounding heights of the city. As a result of the bombardment as a whole some people of the district close to the garrison were killed and the buildings were damaged.

Following the bombardment, about seven thousand people, mainly the families of the prisoners who are kept in three prisons within the garrison, gathered in front of the garrison. In order to disperse the crowd, the soldiers opened fire killing one and injuring two people. The families of the prisoners were demanding the transfer of their children and family members to the city. After the bombardment, the State authorities ordered the people to leave the streets leading to the garrison and announced they would accept no responsibility for the safety of the people who were in the way of the ambulances. The practical result was that some motor-cyclists were overrun by the government vehicles.

## SERIES OF OFFENSIVES BY KOMALA PESHMARGAS AGAINST THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC FORCES

### SAGHEZ

On September 30th, through a series of operations against columns of mobile units of the regime and its military bases, and of confrontations with the regime's forces and control of the roads, in the SAGHEZ-DIVANDARREH road at 13 kms from SAGHEZ, the Komala Peshmargas killed and wounded 15 of the regime's men. They also destroyed 4 military vehicles of the enemy and took nine of its men captive. After the operations and with the enthusiastic reaction of the travellers of the SAGHEZ-DIVANDARREH road who witnessed the battle, the Peshmargas left the area.

### MARIVAN

On September 21st, through a seven and half hour confrontation with the forces of the Islamic Republic at 25 kms from MARIVAN and 6 kms from the MARIVAN-SAGHEZ road, the heroic Peshmargas succeeded in defeating an extensive attack of the enemy. In this battle tens of the enemy men were killed and a complete unit of 11 people were taken captive ; some booty were also taken by our comrades.

Three of the captives were the commanders of the military bases and gendarmerie companies of the Islamic Republic. Komala Peshmargas suffered no losses. During the fighting, the militant toilers of the region assisted our comrades in different ways.

### KOMALA PESHMARGAS IN OCCUPIED CITIES OF KURDISTAN

Three times within a week (on 10, 13 and 17 September) Komala Peshmargas entered SAGHEZ and apart from propagating the policies of the Communist Party of Iran, they subjected two Djash (traitor) of the region to revolutionary execution. They also attacked a military base of the regime, as a result of which 6 of the enemy men were killed and tens more were wounded. Each time after the operation, our comrades safely left the city.

### DIVANDARREH

A unit of Komala Peshmargas entered one of the villages of this region which is surrounded by some important military bases of the regime and after setting fire to two "Danter" and an electric generator of the Jihad of Reconstruction, left the scene.

THE MASSES OF THE PEOPLE OF KURDISTAN DEMAND KDPI  
TO ACCEPT IMMEDIATE CEASEFIRE

The masses of the people of Kurdistan through letters sent to the "Radio Voice of Iran's Revolution" have demanded the immediate termination of the war between the KDPI forces and Komala Peshmargas.

Also the people of seven villages of the FEIZOLLAH BEYGI region (SAGHEZ) have issued the following resolution addressed to the Central Committee of Komala and the Politbureau of KDPI :

"Under the present circumstances where the Islamic Republic regime who is weaker than ever, and not only in Kurdistan but also in other parts of Iran is faced with the discontent and protests of the people, it is necessary that guns be turned towards the Islamic Republic regime ...

We hereby declare our concern with the continuation of the fighting between Komala and the KDPI and we demand :

- 1- an immediate and unconditional cease-fire between the forces of Komala and the KDPI ;
- 2- that the KDPI by accepting the immediate cease-fire respect the wishes of the people of Kurdistan for the termination of the war".

PEOPLE OF KURDISTAN AGAINST THE OCCUPATION  
FORCES OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC, AGAINST  
CONSCRIPTION AND FORCED ARMING

DIVANDARREH

It is now some time that the people of GOOLTAPAH, one of the villages of DIVANDARREH region, are continuing a hard struggle against the regime's policy of forced arming and conscription. On September 3rd, the regime's men surrounded the village and started firing at the villagers' cattle. The villagers protested. The regime's mercenaries opened fire on the people, wounding 1 of the toilers. As a consequence the angry people, women in the front ranks, attacked the regime's military base, passing the barbed wires, forced their way into the prison and released some of the prisoners who had been jailed for their protests and struggles. Following this, the regime replaced the commanders and some of the personnel of the base.

OPPRESSION AND HARASSMENT OF THE PEOPLE  
BY THE REGIME'S FORCES

On September 17th, a villager from one of the villages of GOURAK who had gone hunting was shot dead by the regime's men.

On the same day, one of the regime's guards (Pasdar) over ran with a car a woman causing her severe injuries. This arouse the protest of the people of the city and the guard was beaten by the people.



KOMALA PESHMARGAS CONFRONTING THE ATTACKS  
OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC REGIME'S FORCES

SANANDAJ

On September 11th, the regime's agents attacked one of the units of Komala Peshmargas based in a village near SANANDAJ. Our comrades neutralized the attack by a counter-offensive and killed some of the enemy men. Reinforcements sent from the different military bases of the region were unable to advance in the face of the attacks of our Peshmargas comrades. After a three-hour battle, Komala Peshmargas left the area safely. The body of a commander of the enemy forces was identified among the killed. Some arms and ammunition were taken as booty by our comrades.

BANEH

On September 27th, through a 13 hour battle, our comrades defeated a massive offensive of the regime (170 vehicles) to a village situated 10 kms from BANEH. In this battle 40 of the enemy men were killed and some guns and ammunition were taken as booty. Also 6 people were taken captive and a unit was completely destroyed. During this battle, 4 of our comrades lost their lives.

IN THE WAR FRONTS AGAINST THE KDPI FORCES


SAGHEZ

On September 24th, 2 of the KDPI forces laid a siege to a unit of our Peshmargas comrades in a village of the FEIZOLLAH BEYGI region which led to a confrontation. After 8 hours of fighting, our comrades succeeded in defeating the KDPI forces and forcing them out of the village and the heights surrounding it. In this confrontation many of the KDPI's armed men were killed, the bodies of ten of them were left in the battle field. One of our Peshmargas comrades also lost his life. According to the latest news, after this defeat, the KDPI armed men entered the village, harassed and tortured the villagers and then executed one of them.

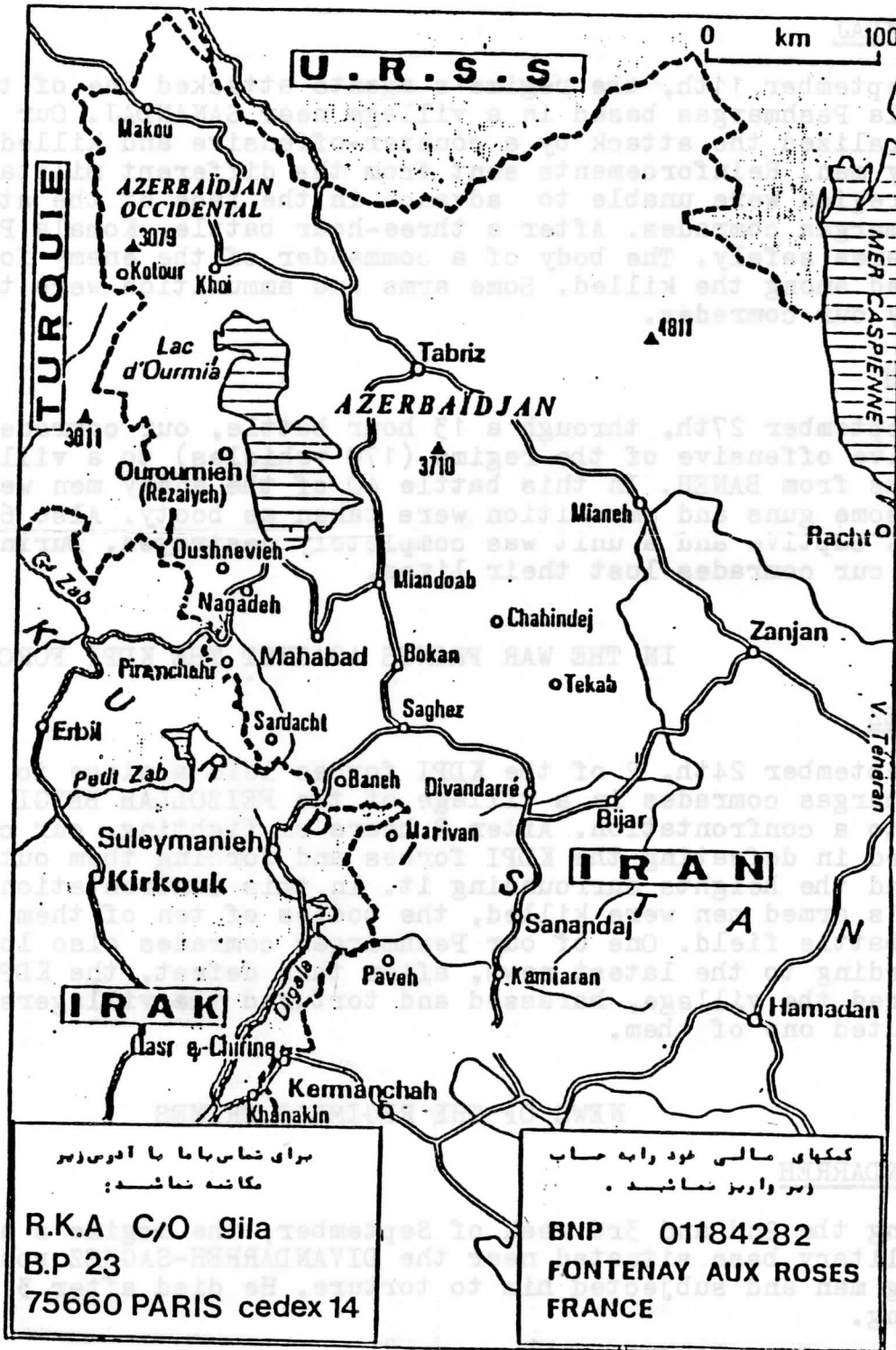
NEWS OF THE REGIME'S CRIMES

DIVANDARREH

During the 2nd and 3rd week of September, the regime's armed men from a military base situated near the DIVANDARREH-SAGHEZ road, arrested a young man and subjected him to torture. He died after 3 days of torturing.

On September 26th, 8 prisoners of war belonging to the gendarmerie company of MARIVAN were released by Komala. One of the released prisoners asked to join the ranks of the Komala Peshmargas.

CONFRONTING REGIME'S ATTACKS

MARIVAN

✽ A massive attack of regime's forces was defeated ✽

On 23rd October, at dawn, the forces of the regime started a massive attack on a region 7 kms from Marivan and 5 kms from the city's garrison which was confronted by our Peshmargas comrades. After an eleven-hour battle, the regime's forces were defeated and had to retreat ; a complete enemy unit was besieged and destroyed and fifty men were killed or wounded. The bodies of 25 of them were in the hands of the Peshmargas, of whom 6 were identified. In this battle, one of the regime's men was captured and some booty were taken by our comrades. In the heat of the confrontation, five of our comrades lost their lives.

BANEH

On 27th October, late in the morning, the forces of the Islamic Republic regime attacked a village in the Baneh region, intending to strike a blow at Komala Peshmargas. A unit of our comrades who were present in the village confronted the enemy and having neutralized their attack, forced the attackers to flee. The reinforcement sent from the city of Baneh faced the same fate. As such, after a five-hour battle, the last attempt of the regime was defeated. In this confrontation, some losses were inflicted upon the enemy forces and some booty were taken by our comrades.

SAGHEZ

On 23rd October, some units of Komala Peshmargas noted extensive movements of the regime's forces and the reinforcement of the military bases around the village where they were present. The regime's forces did not, however, dare to advance, but from a far distance started bombarding the areas around the village. The bombardment lasting an hour did not inflict any loss upon our Peshmargas or the people in the village.

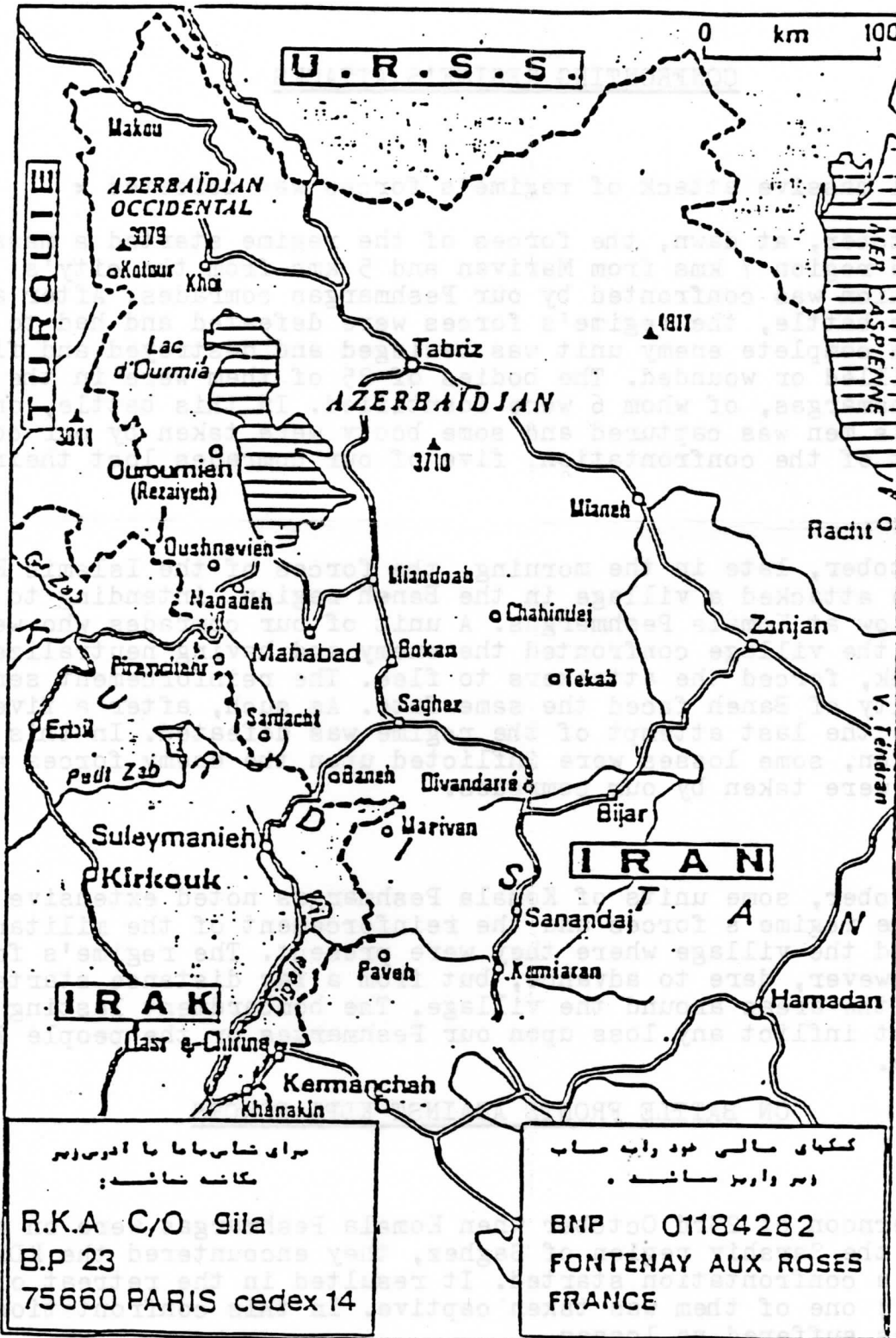
ON BATTLE FRONTS AGAINST KDPI FORCES

SAGHEZ

In the afternoon of 23rd October when Komala Peshmargas were on a mission in the Sarshiv region of Saghez, they encountered the KDPI forces and a confrontation started. It resulted in the retreat of the latter ; one of them was taken captive. In this confrontation, our comrades suffered no losses.

KDPI PESHMARGAS PRESENTED THEMSELVES TO THE  
KOMALA PESHMARGAS FORCE

During the last week, six of the KDPI Peshmargas becoming aware of the aggressive and anti-democratic policy of the KDPI leadership, left the ranks of this party and presented themselves to the Komala Peshmargas. The assistant commander of one of the KDPI forces is among them.





ON WAR FRONTS AGAINST THE ISLAMIC  
REPUBLIC FORCES

SANANDAJ

From 26th to 29th October, Komala Peshmargas from the 11th regiment of Sanandaj confronted five times the regime forces in the villages of the Sanandaj region. The efforts of the enemy to strike a blow to the Peshmargas were neutralized each time. During these confrontations, our comrades suffered no losses. Several agents of the regime were killed or wounded. Five of the enemy men were captured and some booty were taken by our comrades.

BOUKAN

On 31st October, Komala Peshmargas confronted the regime forces in a village in the Gourak region. Two of the regime agents were killed and the rest ran away. The enemy forces bombarded the village from their bases in the region with mortar shells thus inflicting material damages upon its inhabitants.

CONFRONTATIONS WITH THE KDPI FORCES

BOUKAN

In the afternoon of 1st November, a unit of Komala Peshmargas who were on a mission, came across the KDPI forces and a heavy battle broke out between them. During this confrontation which lasted six hours, the offensive of the KDPI forces was defeated and eight of its men were killed or injured. Our comrades continued their mission after the confrontation. During this battle one of our comrades lost his life.

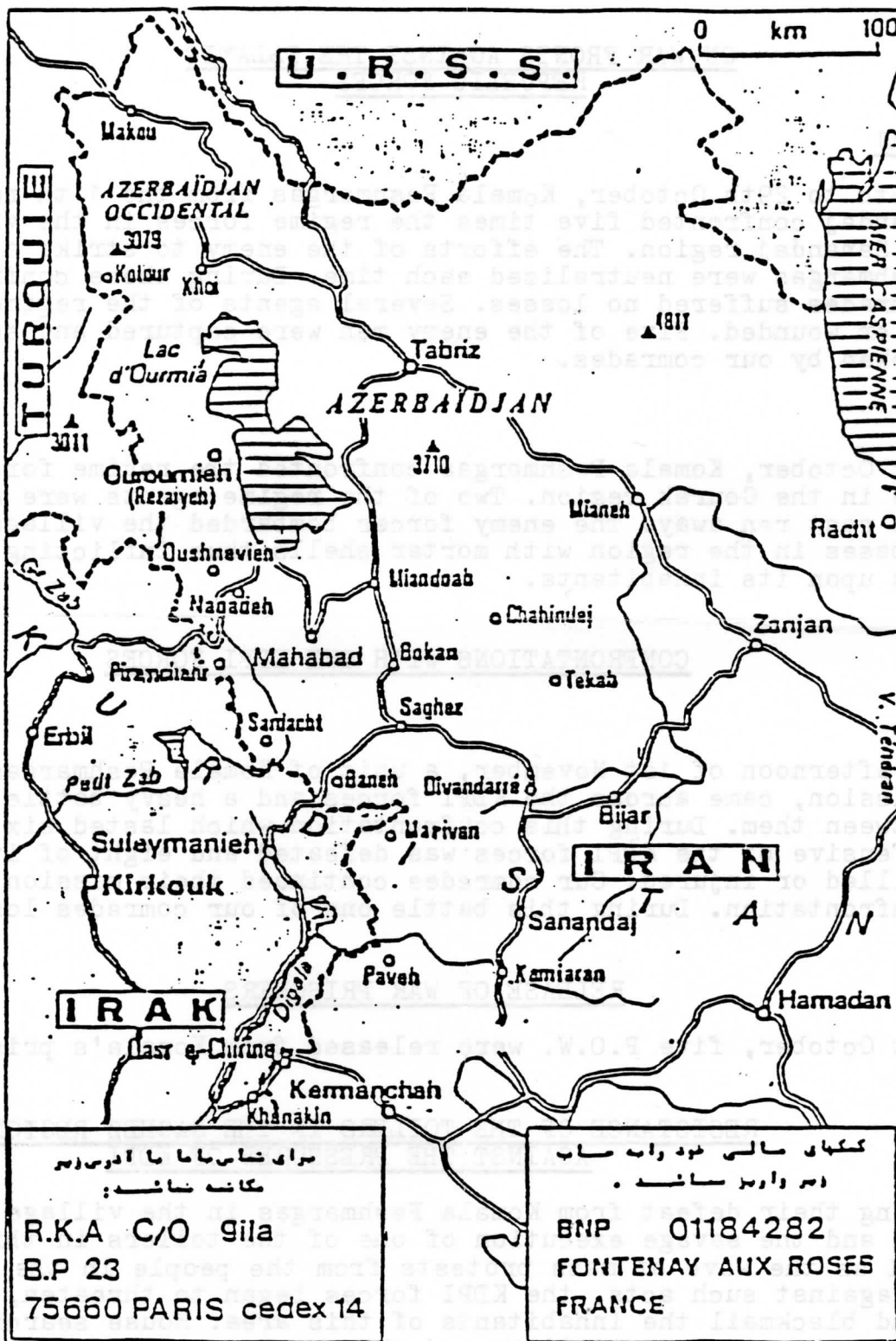
RELEASE OF WAR PRISONERS

On 31st October, five P.O.W. were released from Komala's prison.

RESISTANCE OF THE TOILERS IN THE SAGHEZ REGION  
AGAINST THE PRESSURES OF KDPI

Following their defeat from Komala Peshmargas in the village of Bash Boulagh and the savage execution of one of the toilers in this village as well as the wave of mass protests from the people in the Saghez region against such acts, the KDPI forces began to threaten, intimidate and blackmail the inhabitants of this area. House searches, insulting the people, extortions and threats have nowadays become a routine work of the KDPI forces.

They have particularly exerted considerable pressures on the inhabitants of three villages in the region and have harassed them. But the reply of the toiling and fighting people of these villages has been resistance against the pressures of the KDPI forces and protests against their acts.

CONFRONTATIONS WITH REGIME FORCES

SANANDAJ

On 18th November, at dawn, Komala Peshmargas seized the entire base of the regime's forces in a village located 8 kms from the main Sanandaj-Marivan road. During this battle which lasted an hour and a half, 16 enemy men were taken captives and a considerable amount of booty was taken by our comrades. Moreover, some losses were inflicted upon the regime's forces. Komala Peshmargas suffered no losses.

SANANDAJ

In order to strike a blow at Komala Peshmargas around the city of Sanandaj, the regime's forces attacked the villages located in the south and south-west of the city. During a thirteen-hour battle which ensued between Komala Peshmargas stationed in these areas and the forces of occupation many losses were inflicted on the enemy. During this confrontation, one of Komala Peshmargas lost his life.

KAMIARAN

On the night of 28th October, Komala Peshmargas stationed in a village around Kamiaran, attacked the regime's strike force after noticing their movements. During the first moments of this confrontation, a hated Djash of the area was killed and two others were injured.

SAGHEZ

On the evening of 17th November, a unit of Komala Peshmargas entered the city of Saghez and attacked one of the enemy bases. During this offensive which lasted one hour, some losses were inflicted on the enemy forces. Komala Peshmargas suffered no losses.

ON BATTLE FRONTS AGAINST KDPI FORCES

NORTH OF KURDISTAN

On 13th November, at dawn, a heavy fighting broke out in Margour between Komala Peshmargas and the KDPI forces. Some Komala Peshmargas lost their lives or were taken captives. During this battle, some KDPI men were also killed.

MARIVAN

On 28th October, a unit of Komala Peshmargas were fired upon by some KDPI men near a village close to the city. During this savage attack, one of our comrades lost his life.

STRUGGLES OF MASSES IN KURDISTAN AGAINST  
FORCED ARMING

MARIVAN

The people armed by force in a village of the Marivan region gave their arms back after six months of resistance and protests. The suppressive forces besieged the village during the night and arrested 11 people. But after many efforts they only succeeded in arming 7 people.

MARIVAN

Four forcefully armed persons from one of the villages around Marivan who had been taken captives by Komala Peshmargas during the seizure of the base of the regime forces, were arrested and imprisoned by enemy's forces after their release from the prison of Komala. One of these persons was executed after being severely tortured. The three others are still in prison.

SAGHEZ-FEYZOLLAH BEYGUI

The pressures of the regime's forces have been intensified in this region. The occupying forces of the regime besiege the villages during the night and search the houses in order to arrest young people. Despite the efforts of the regime in two villages, only 14 men have been armed. The regime has not had any success in the remaining villages.

SARSHIV-MARIVAN

On 1st November, following the resistance of the inhabitants of one of the villages of this area against the threats of the regime, the suppressive forces swarmed the village, insulting and beating two people. The village people attacked government forces with stones and sticks and drove them out of the village.

RELEASE OF P.O.W.

- On 3rd and 13th November, six P.O.W. who had been captured during the recent confrontations between Komala Peshmargas and the Islamic Republic forces were released from Komala prisons.
- On 2nd November, three PDKI men, taken captives by Komala Peshmargas during battles which had taken place in the south of Kurdistan, were released from Komala prisons. After being released, one of them volunteered to join the ranks of Komala Peshmargas.

TOILING MEN AND WOMEN GET ARMED

On 5th November, a military unit (Pal) of revolutionary and toiling men and women were armed in the Komala Peshmargas Training Centre after having completed their politico-military training course.



AMBUSHES AND CONTROL OF ROADS

SAGHEZ

In the afternoon of 19th November, some units of Komala Peshmargas in a location 8 kms from the city of Saghez and by the Marivan-Saghez road ambushed a unit of the enemy forces. All the unit's men were killed in this operation. The enemy tried twice to send reinforcements but none was successful. In this battle tens of enemy men were killed or wounded; 14 bodies were left in the battle-field. Komala Peshmargas suffered no losses ; they took some booty.

IN BATTLE FRONTS AGAINST KDPI FORCES

SARSHIV of SAGHEZ

In a series of battles which took place from 14th to 16th November between Komala Peshmargas and the KDPI forces, the leadership committee of one of the southern regions of Kurdistan and the military forces of the latter were pushed back from their bases. In these battles at least 6 of KDPI men were killed or injured. Two of Komala Peshmargas also lost their lives.

SAGHEZ

On 11th November, the armed men of KDPI besieged the house of one of the toilers of a village, where the Komala Peshmargas were resting and opened fire. After two hours the people of the village along with Komala Peshmargas drove the KDPI men out of the village.

BOUKAN

In a confrontation between Komala Peshmargas and the armed men of KDPI, at least 5 KDPI men were killed or wounded. Komala Peshmargas suffered no losses.

RELEASE OF P.O.W.

- On 11th November, one of KDPI men who had been taken captive by Komala Peshmargas on 22nd May in the south of Kurdistan, was released from the Komala prison.
- On 15th November, a gendarmerie sergeant was released from the Komala prison.

IN THE WAR FRONTS AGAINST THE  
FORCES OF DPKI

On September 10th, at midnight, eleven Peshmargas of Komala who were in a jail of the DPKI, escaped from the jail with the help of their jailers. Four previous Peshmargas of the DPKI who had played an active role in this escape, joined the ranks of the Peshmargas of Komala. Now there are only two Peshmargas of Komala in DPKI's jails.

JAVEHROOD

On September 2nd, a unit of Komala Peshmargas became the target of a surprise attack by the armed men of the DPKI. This resulted in a confrontation. At the same time, the forces of the Islamic Republic also attacked the positions of our comrades, but the Komala Peshmargas were able to raise the siege laid by the two and inflict some losses on them. Regretably, in this epic fighting four of our comrades lost their lives.

BANEH

In a confrontation between the Komala Peshmargas and DPKI forces on the night of September 8th, one of DPKI's men was killed and the rest ran away. In this fighting, the mother of one of the Komala Peshmargas lost her life.

DPKI'S PESHMARGAS JOIN KOMALA

During the late August and early September of this year, ten of DPKI's men surrendered themselves to the Peshmargas of Komala who welcomed them enthusiastically. Also, three DPKI's Peshmargas, who had cooperated with our comrades in their escape from the DPKI's jail, joined the ranks of Komala.

KOMALA PESHMARGAS IN OCCUPIED TOWNS OF  
KURDISTAN

On 10th and 13th September, some Komala Peshmargas units entered the town of Saghez. In the operations of the first day, the Peshmargas subjected a notorious Jash (traitor) of the town to revolutionary execution and in the second day they attacked a base of the regime inflicting upon the enemy some losses and damages. As usual, each

time our comrades explained the positions and policies of the Communist Party of Iran to the people and then left safely the town.

THE REVOLUTIONARY SOLDIERS JOIN THE  
RANKS OF KOMALA PESHMARGAS

On 3rd September, 14 revolutionary soldiers from a village of Boukan and on 12th September, a deceived and forcefully armed man from one of the villages of Marivan left the regime's forces and joined the Komala Peshmargas.

RELEASE OF PRISONERS

On 10th September, two soldiers were released from the Komala's jail.

STRUGGLES OF THE PEOPLE OF KURDISTAN AGAINST  
THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC REGIME

SAGHEZ

On 10th September, one of the regime's Pasdars was assassinated by the fighters of this town.

On this day, the regime's forces attacked a village in Gourak, district of Saghez, taking the young people of the village for conscription. Despite these pressures, the struggle of the people to defeat the regime's policy of conscription and forceful arming of the people continues.

BUKAN - FEIZOLLAH BEYGI

On 21st August, five girls from the village of Gholeh Balagi accused to be sympathisers of Komala were arrested alongside three men from the village by the mercenaries of the regime. As a result of the demonstrations and protestes by the villagers, the regime's forces had to release all of them.
