But parties like the Socialist Workers Party have to survive without any help from rich friends. Our own members make a regular contribution to keep the party

The Labour Party and Democratic Left are doing everything to help the establishment cover up what was going on. Dick Spring got huge numbers of votes in the last election because he said that he was against the Golden Circle. But we now know that his party got £10,000 from the Dunnes family to help Mary Robinson's Presidential election.

must from working class people themselves.
