

**BOLDLY MOBILIZE THE MASSES AND COMPLETELY SMASH COUNTERREVOLUTIONARY BLACK GANGS
(16 June 1966)**

The revolutionary students, staff, and teachers of Nanking University have dug out anti-party, anti-socialist counterrevolutionary element Kuang Ya-ming (0562 0068 2494). This is a matter of great joy for the people.

The reorganization of the Peiping Municipal Committee of the Communist Youth

League (CYL), the dismissal from their offices of those anti-party, anti-socialist elements, and the recapture of the leadership from them are also matters of great joy for the people.

Of late, the masses of workers, peasants, and soldiers, the masses of revolutionary cadres, and the masses of revolutionary intellectuals have held high the great red banner of Mao Tse-tung's thought, vigorously carried out the proletarian cultural revolution, attacked all the pertinacious bulwarks of the bourgeoisie, and scored one victory after another.

What does the counterrevolutionary case of Kuang Ya-ming suppressing the revolutionary mass movement tell us?

It tells us that all monsters like Kuang Ya-ming and all the anti-party, anti-socialist counterrevolutionary black gangs will never withdraw from the historical arena of their own accord, and are never reconciled to their defeat. They will inevitably resist desperately, make dying last kicks, and adopt all kinds of vicious and malicious means to suppress the revolutionary mass movement, so as to maintain their tottering counterrevolutionary rule.

The anti-party, anti-socialist representatives of the bourgeoisie, making use of the name of the party, set up a number of departments under their control positions for carrying out anti-party activities. They used a complete set of instruments for exercising dictatorship to deal with the revolutionary masses and the proletarian leftists. They resisted the current great cultural revolution initiated by the party Central Committee and Chairman Mao in a well-organized, well-planned, and well-guided way. Before the masses took action, they began to stir up ill winds, spread rumors, created confusion to divert the people's attention, and set up heavy obstacles to bind the hands and feet of the masses. Hardly had the proletarian leftists begun to speak and put up a few big-character posters, when they flew into a rage and mounted joint attacks on the leftists by bawling and threatening them, trumping up criminal charges against them, and subjecting them to political persecution. These fellows had a strange logic: Whoever exposed them and whoever opposed the black gangs were labeled as being "anti-party" and "opposing the party Central Committee." But by so doing, they precisely ran counter to their wishes, showed fully their true counterrevolutionary colors as royalists, and sounded the death knell for their complete defeat.

To those departments and units whose leadership had been usurped by the representatives of the bourgeoisie, the current great cultural revolution is a struggle to fight for leadership, and a struggle to turn bourgeoisie dictatorship into proletarian dictatorship.

In carrying out this struggle, we should by no means adopt the method of reformism, or advocate "peaceful transition" or "combining two into one," but should take a completely revolutionary measures to dig out all the monsters and freaks and overthrow them.

In order to win this struggle, we must boldly mobilize the masses. One's attitude toward the mass movement, supporting it or opposing it, is an extremely important criterion for distinguishing revolution from counter-revolution. We must warmly and wholeheartedly support the revolutionary mass movement, actively plunge ourselves into this movement, and give correct guidance to this movement. We must resolutely rely upon the proletarian leftist and, with workers, peasants, and soldiers as the main forces for the revolution, and uniting the more than 95 percent of the masses of people, and more than 95 percent of the cadres, concentrate our firing power on the anti-party, anti-socialist black gangs, the stubborn bulwarks of the bourgeoisie, and all the monsters and demons.

The revolutionary big-character posters are a magic mirror to reflect all the monsters and freaks, which serve as a most effective method of boldly mobilizing the masses to launch a fierce attack on the enemy. All anti-party, anti-socialist counterrevolutionary elements are afraid of big-character posters. All the revolutionary people like big-character posters very much and regard them as the most powerful new-type weapon to expose and defeat the enemy.

By putting up big-character posters we will be able to expose all anti-party, anti-socialist crimes and dig up all anti-party, anti-socialist black gangs, thus making them find no place to conceal themselves or hide. Yes, we are going to put up more big-character posters, conduct more debates, air fully our views, boost the morale of the proletarian leftists and the revolutionary masses, and crush the arrogance of the representatives of the bourgeoisie, the "academic authorities" of the bourgeoisie, and all the monsters and freaks. We must launch attacks on all the stubborn bulwarks of the bourgeoisie. The names of those anti-party, anti-socialist representatives of the bourgeoisie who oppose Mao Tse-tung's thought and continue to ride roughshod over the people must be put on the posters; they must be dismissed from their duties and offices; they must be deprived of leadership; and the units to which they belong must be reorganized.

Such a unit as the former Peiping Municipal CCP Committee which persisted in opposing the party, socialism, and Mao Tse-tung's thought is one which must be reorganized. Such a unit as the former Peiping Municipal CYL Committee, an accomplice of the former Peiping Municipal CCP Committee, which frenziedly poisoned the minds of youths and children, is one which must be reorganized. The chieftains of these stubborn counterrevolutionary bulwarks are the ones who must be dismissed from their offices.

We must boldly mobilize the masses, overthrow all the anti-party, anti-socialist counterrevolutionary black gangs opposing Mao Tse-tung's thought, recapture all the positions usurped by them, and make the proletariat have a firm grip on these positions.

We must hold high the great red banner of Mao Tse-tung's thinking and carry through the great proletarian cultural revolution to the end. We will not call off the fight until final victory is achieved.
