[Text] "Over Chungshan swept a storm headlong. Our mighty army, a million strong, has crossed the great river." The situation of the great proletarian cultural revolution is excellent. The whole situation is more favorable than ever before. However, the nearer the great proletarian cultural revolution goes to the all-round victory, the more desperate the class enemy will become in its last-ditch struggle to frenziedly subvert. Therefore, class struggle is still sharp and acute.
