

Unionists Back Palestine Rally

The Trade Union Committee for Jewish Unity has endorsed the Madison Square Garden demonstration to be held Sunday evening under the auspices of the American Zionist Emergency Council, it was announced yesterday.

In a statement issued by Max Perlow, chairman; Joseph Levy, secretary; and Maurice Rosenberg, Administrative secretary, the Trade Union Committee urged affiliated and cooperating trade unions "to do all they can to help publicize this anti-imperialist demonstration."

"It will call for the abrogation of the unjust and discriminatory Palestine White Paper of 1939 that the British Government still enforces, thereby effectively barring Jewish immigration to Palestine" they said.

Because the Dubinsky-dominated anti-unity Jewish Labor Committee is opposed to this rally, the statement added the Trade Union Committee for Jewish Unity has arranged with garment worker rank and filers to distribute leaflets publicizing the rally at noon on Friday in the garment area.

Leaflets are also being distributed by the Furriers, locals of the United Office and Professional Workers of America, Wholesale and Warehouse Workers, and other unions.
